#### 1) Welcome & Administrative Matters - Shelly Heinrich

- The PTA board and school administration introduced themselves
- The meeting agenda was approved
- The December 2020 meeting minutes were approved

# 2) Presentation: Managing Technology Limitations and Etiquette During COVID (Anna Maria Lechleitner and Amy Blaine):

- Ms. Lechleitner explained that the Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) is an agreement signed annually, providing expectations for appropriate use of technology based on age and usage.
- Ms. Blaine discussed the Digital Citizenship Curriculum, which is collaboratively taught between teachers, ITC, and librarian to guide appropriate use, responsible choice of resources, and respectful behavior and work on electronic devices.
  Students are strongly encouraged to perform research using APS library databases.
- Common Sense Media (https://www.commonsensemedia.org/) was recommended as a very useful tool for parents and students to select age appropriate movies, books, TV, and apps. The site also provides a template for a family media agreement and suggestions for safety during distance learning.
- What are things parents should look out for? What are new threats? Parents should be overseeing accounts for sites/apps like Discord, YouTube, etc. and follow age guidelines. Clear expectations should be set for screen use, screens should always be visible to parents, and open lines of communication.
- *Are there new apps for parental controls we should be looking for: Ms.* Lechleitner will compile information and send a follow up email with resources for parents.
- Books Before Bedtime is scheduled again for Jan 13th, 7-7:30pm.

#### 3) Principal's Report- Michelle McCarthy

- Ms. McCarthy thanked the community for generously giving to Randolph and Jamestown families in need over the holidays.
- Jodee Jones recently retired as school registrar. The new registrar is Loren Fuentes: lorenza.fuentes@apsva.us.
- Congratulations to Meagan Kalchbrenner, Julie Landefeld, Kaitlyn Mackrell, and Lindsey Nathan, who recently earned National Board Certification.
- Return to school updates will be provided at January 7th school board meeting.
- JES student enrollment data was shared: in June 2020, 615 students were enrolled, and as of January 2021, 500 students are enrolled. The current enrollment is not impacting staffing.
- There was a parent question about whether the PTA could purchase air filters for classrooms. Ms. McCarthy explained that the school will provide all air filters to ensure COVID air quality compliance in classrooms.
- There was a parent question about whether JES leadership engages in private meetings about school reopening. Ms. McCarthy explained that they have no
